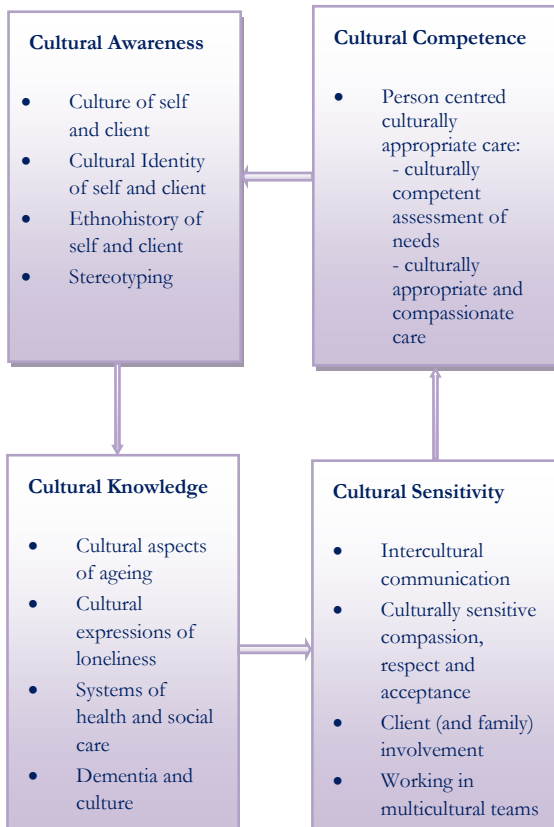

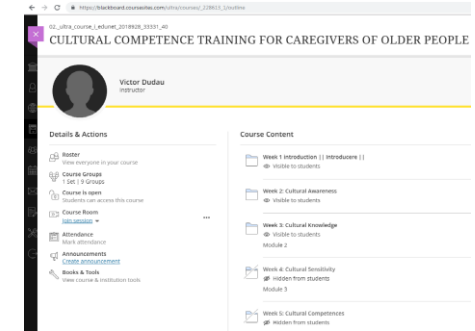
The Learning Tools

Massive Open Online Course (MOOC)

The CULTURAL COMPETENCE TRAINING FOR CAREGIVERS OF OLDER PEOPLE course is embedded on the Blackboard platform and addresses the foreigner and migrant caregivers of older people.



The Course is for six weeks, has six Modules and each module is five days long.

Week 1: Orientation

Week 2: Cultural Awareness

Week 3: Cultural Knowledge

Week 4: Cultural Sensitivity

Week 5: Cultural Competence

Week 6: Assessment and evaluation

Participants will be graded and will receive certificates with credits for course.
